### Third Year Program Making Strides

The 1995-96 Northeastern Illinois University Men's Soccer Team established its position as one of Chicago's finest NCAA Division I programs. With victories over three of Chicago's four Division I universities, the Golden Eagles took a major step forward in only its second full season.

Although still in its "infancy", NEIU proved to be no child in the NCAA Division I ranks. With 12 of their 18 matches decided by a goal or less, the Golden Eagles were competitive far beyond their years.

The 1996-97 campaign sees the Golden Eagles Soccer Team return 10 lettermen. Although the majority of their roster will again consist of underclassmen, the Golden Eagles will return five Juniors and their first ever senior.

Coach Hannan's 1996-96 recruiting class continues to build upon his previous quality classes. This years new student-athletes come to Chicago by way of Texas, Florida, Wisconsin, Greece and Southern parts of Illinois. These young men are expected to battle for starting roles.

The 1996-97 Northeastern Illinois University soccer season promises to continue to build upon its already impressive start. The secret is out that the Golden Eagle soccer program has high goals and ambitions and has every intention on keeping them. With exciting home dates at the PE Complex Fields, don't dare miss these men in action.

## NORTHEASTERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY 1996 SOCCER FACTS • FIGURES • MILESTONES

- The 1995 season will be year number three for Coach John Hannan and his young NE Illinois soccer program....Hannan started the program from the ground up in 1993 with an abreviated season before the first two full NCAA Division I schedules contested in 1994 and 1995
- The Golden Eagles were the "Road Warriors" of college soccer in 1994 with 18 oftheir 20 games on the road..NEIU was 1-1 at home and 0-18 on the road in 1994....The Golden Eagles played 9 home games in 1995 at the PE Complex fields on campus (1-7-1) and will be at home six times this season.
- The 1994 season of "firsts" included the first NCAA Division I win..a 1-0 home win over Valparaiso (October 26, 1994) on a goal by Ivan Rodriguez in the second half to edge the Crusaders in Chicago at the PE Complex Fields.
- NEIU's all-time scoring leader Curt Stevens has led the Golden Eagles with 4 goals in both the 1994 and 1995 seasons....Stevens has 8 career goals and 2 assists for 18 career points in two seasons.
- The Golden Eagles first-ever road win was last year at Northwestern 4-3 (Sept. 10, 1995) with Jimmy Ferrando scoring the game-winning goal.
- Northeastern Illinois senior captain Fernando "Chile" Ferrer is the soccer programs first four-year player. Fernando played the abreviated season in 1993 and has been a two-year starter in 1994 and 1995.

### HEAD SOCCER COACH JOHN HANNAN

John Hannan and his Northeastern Illinois University Men's Soccer Program begins their third full NCAA Division I season this Fall. They began their journey into the depths of NCAA Division I play in the Fall of 1993 with a provisional season. The Golden Eagles play in the very competitive Mid-Continent Conference.

Coach Hannan returns nine starters from his 1995-96 campaign, to go along with the seven newly signed student-athletes and a selected group of walk-ons. Coach Hannan will rely heavily on the experience and leadership that his NEIU Soccer Team returns.

Coach Hannan came to Chicago following a successful collegiate career at Western Kentucky University. Coach Hannan was a four-year letter winner as a "Hilltopper" and was a four-time selection on the Sun Belt Conference all-academic team. He earned his bachelor's degree in 1988 and a master's degree from WKU in 1991.

Coach Hannan's coaching background includes work as an assistant coach at Western Kentucky University and as head coach at Elizabethtown High Schools earning Kentucky District Coach of the Year honors in 1992. Coach Hannan serves as a Region II Olympic Development Program Staff Coach. He also serves as a Staff Instructor in the Illinois State Soccer Coaching Schools.

Coach Hannan is quite involved on the local scene. He coaches in the Chicago Magic Soccer Club where he has guided his teams to two State Cup Championship in two seasons. He also works with a local middle school in helping to promote soccer in the cities junior high schools. The mission of this project is to serve as an anti-gang program and to promote a positive self image.



Northeastern serves as an affordable educational and cultural resource for the northern metropolitan Chicago area, fulfilling an important role in Illinois high education.


