Only Cast Members and Company Members That are concerned with Performance are allowed in the Green Room/DRESSING ROOM AREA AFTER 5:30 PM. I BELIEVE IN REEPING ACTORS ISOLATED PRIOR TO PERFORMANCE AND YOU MAY NOT RECEIVE YOUR ADORING PUBLIC UNTIL AFTER PERFORMANCE AND AFTER YOU ARE OUT OF MAKE-UP AND COSTUMES AND INTO STREET CLOTHES.
