Auditions for Lanford Wilson's comedy/drama HOT L BALTIMORE will be held early next week:

Monday and Tuesday, February 4 and 5, 7:00pm each evening

Guest David Kropp will direct the three-act production. The action takes place in the lobby of a once fine hotel now gone to seed and about to be demolished. Characters include three hookers, all warmhearted but of distinct varieties; an elderly, wellbred, tolerant spinster with insomnia; an elderly, peevish man with hypochondria; a closed-faced tomboy lesbian hipped on ecology and health foods; and a desk clerk, delivery boy, cab driver, along with other characters.

As the action unfolds, the residents, ranging from young to old, from the defiant to the resigned, meet and talk and interact with each other during the course of one day. The drama is of passing events in their lives, of everyday encounters and of the human comedy. Performances are slated for the last two weekends in April.

10 men and seven women are needed for the cast.
