ANATOL

AN UNROMANTIC COMEDY

The University Theatre's mainstage production for the spring term is Arthur Schnitzler's Anatol.

In Anatol, playwright Arthur Schnitzler explores the romantic attachments of his title character with seven different women. Written in Vienna in 1893, Schnitzler's fascination with Freud's discoveries of the subconscious underlies the action as Anatol moves from woman to woman, searching for ideal love. Anatol provides a fresh, sharp and witty picture of relations between the sexes.

The play is under the direction of Dexter Bullard, Artistic Associate Director of the Next Theatre Company. The set and lighting designs are by Robert G. Smith, with costumes by Smith and Bullard. Mr. Bullard's production of Bouncers for the Next Laboratory Theatre, also designed by Robert G. Smith, won five Joseph Jefferson awards in 1991: for direction, best production, ensemble, lighting and music.
